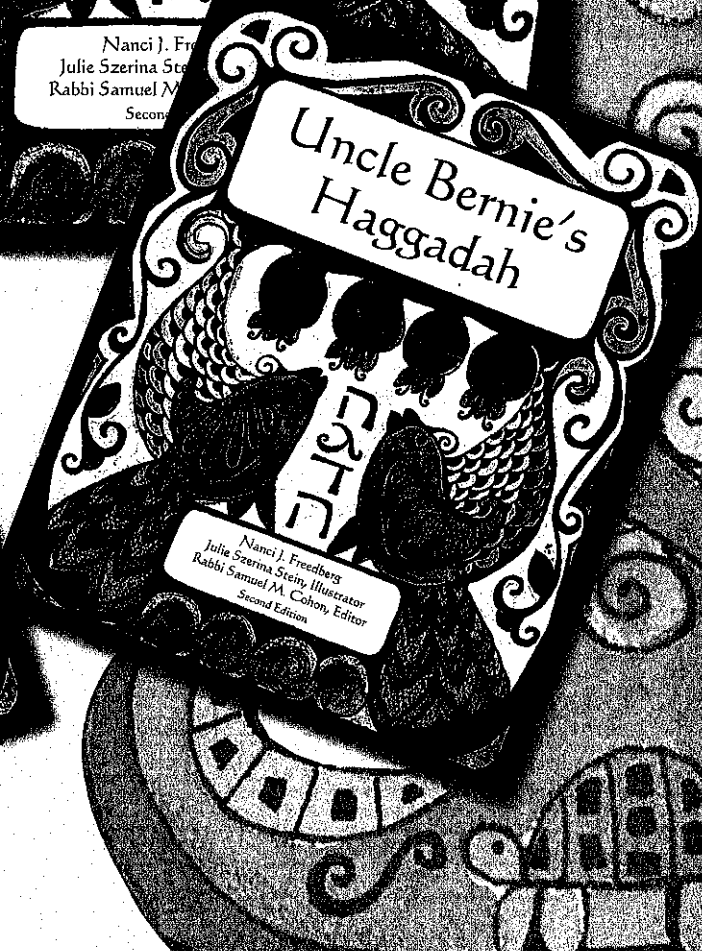
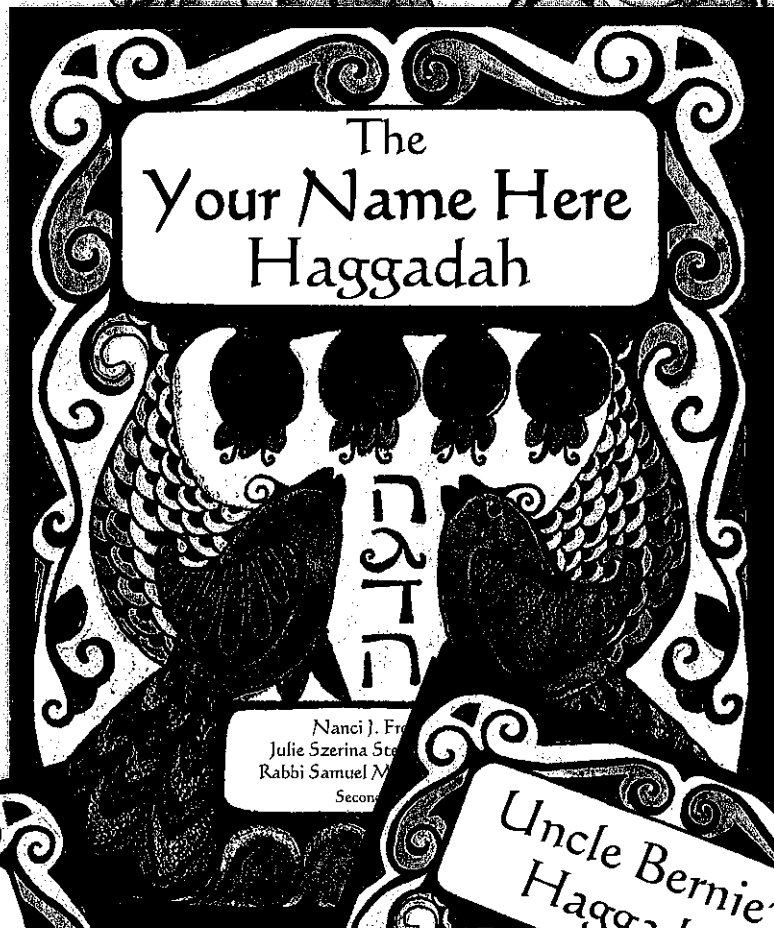

Order of the Seder

These are the signs of the Seder. We sing and remember the way God freed us from slavery with glory and power on this festival day

Kadesh	קדוש	Sing the kiddush for the first cup of wine
Uchatz	ורחץ	Wash hands without saying a blessing
Karpas	קרפס	Dip the greens into salt water
Yachatz	יחצץ	Break the middle matzah
Magid	מגיד	Tell the story of Passover & the second cup of wine
Rachitzah	רחיצה	Wash hands with a blessing
Motzi	מוציא	Sing the blessing for the bread
Maror	מרור	Sing the blessing over the matzah
Korech	קורח	Make a sandwich of bitter herbs & charoset
Shulchan Orech	שולחן ערוך	Eat the Passover meal
Tzafun	צפון	Find and eat the Afikoman
Beirach	ברכה	Sing the blessing after the meal
Hafot	הפלה	Sing songs of praise
Nirtzah	נרצח	Drink the fourth cup of wine and conclude
