The JCC of Central New Jersey is rolling out its Active Adult programming for the fall

Beginning in mid-September, the Senior and Active Adult Department is launching its fall programming. On Wednesday, September 16, Harry and Naomi Zaslow, who have both published their memoirs, will share with the audience their writing process and what it has meant for them, their family and their readers. Moving into October, Broadway Babies on Monday, October 12, will feature Cathy and Michael Chimentis, who will entertain the audience with live cabaret. This event is sponsored in memory of Fanny Kutin by her family. Next up, on Wednesday, October 21, the JCC and Jewish National Fund are hosting guest speaker, Dr. Eva Mor, who has dedicated her career to bettering the lives of seniors. Lunch will be served at all programs; reservations are required in advance.

Three exciting trips are also slated for the fall. The first is to Barnes Gallery in Merion Station, PA on Sunday, October 25. The Barnes Foundation holds the leading private collection of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist art in the world. Lunch is included at a nearby restaurant. On November 10, guests are invited to the Montclair Art Museum for a docent-led tour of the exhibit which examines Cezanne's profound influence upon development of American modernism. The last trip of the fall is scheduled for Thursday, December 3 to the Lower East Side Tenement Museum and Eldridge Street Synagogue. Lunch at Katz's Delicatessen, "New York's oldest and best delicatessen," is included. Advance reservations for both trips are required.

Holiday lunches and complementary programming will be held throughout the fall. On Tuesday, September 15, Cantor Walton will enchant audiences with beautiful cantorial music especially for Rosh Hashanah. The Thanksgiving celebration on Tuesday, November 17, features Ronald MacCloskey as Groucho Marx, who will entertain the audience. Mark Levy will help celebrate Hanukkah and the New Year with his holiday program *Oy, Hanukkah* on Wednesday, December 16. Advance reservations are needed for these programs as well.

As always, the Senior program meets every Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 9:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Creative Art, Senior Exercise and Jewish Culture are just some of the classes offered. Kosher lunch is provided at a nominal fee and open to the community. (Advance reservations are required.) Transportation is usually available for Union County residents.
